3rd Place • \$1 (White Ribbon)**

Rules: Exhibits must have been photographed by NEBRASKA AMATEUR PHOTOGRAPHERS and shall not have been exhibited in any prior Boone County Fair. No exhibits from PROFESSIONALS will be accepted. A PROFESSIONAL is deemed to be anyone who derives 50% or more of their income from the taking or processing of photographs and/or is listed in any directory as a photographer or film processor. The final decision on the amateur status of an entrant will be solely the responsibility of the superintendent.

All photographs must have been taken by the exhibitor, and he/she must have the original print, slide or negative. All exhibits are entered at the exhibitors risk. The Boone County Fairboard, Photography Department and its workers will not be responsible for any damage to the exhibits. Reasonable care will be exercised to prevent damage to any entry. The Superintendent reserves the right to refuse any entry deemed not suitable for fair competition and to reclassify any entry incorrectly classified.

Photos are to be a minimum of 5x7 inches and maximum 16x20 inches. Matting may be used.

Each exhibit will be judged on the following criteria using a 1-10 scale, with 10 being the best. Points will be awarded in each category with the highest total score being the winner. In the case of a tie, an additional judge will make the final decision. 1. Subject matter - in the right class with an appropriate title. 2. Composition - focal point, balance, the way the print is framed within your lens. 3. Quality - focus, color and depth of field. 4. Creativity - uniqueness and different from other photos.

Only one entry per person is allowed per class number.

Class 1 - Color Prints

Prints made by any color photo process will be accepted under this heading. The exhibitor must have made the original exposure from which the print was made. This lot includes panoramic prints with a mount board no larger than 11x16.

- 11. Animals and Nature - A-plants, B-flowers, C-insects, D-animals
- 12. Still Life - A-table top arrangements or B-still objects of interest
- 13. Portraits - A-formal, B-posed settings of people
- 14. Group of people — A-formal, B-posed setting of people
- 15. Candid Shots - A-action, B-unexpected photo or C-photo of everyday life
- 16. Unclassified - photos not readily classified in any of the above classifications

Class 2 - Black and White Prints
