BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Superintendents will have full and complete charge of everything in their departments, and will be looked to for careful arrangement and management, and also for the proper entertainment of the public in their respective areas.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

STATE FIRE REGULATIONS

- 1) Smoking is prohibited in all buildings.
- 2) The use of excessive electric leads, faulty electrical equipment, and excessive use of electric extension cords, shall be prohibited.
- 3) Candles or other open flame devices shall not be used in booths, stands, or buildings.

BEHAVIOR ON THE GROUNDS

- 1) While the greatest possible care will be exercised by the management to protect patrons of the Boone County Fair, each individual will be held personally responsible for his or her own actions.
- 2) Patrons of the fair are to conduct themselves in a lawful, cooperative manner at all times.
- 3) Parents of minor children will be held responsible for the actions of said children and the management will not be held accountable or responsible for any injury. Parents are particularly cautioned to supervise the actions of their minor children while on said fairgrounds since it is apparent that danger exists when children are permitted to run at large on the grounds without supervision.

CONCESSIONS, BOOTHS, VENDORS

- 1) NO Alcohol on grounds except in the beer garden.
- 2) All dining halls, lunch booths, refreshment pavilions and other stands must be neat in appearance and meet state regulations.
- 3) The Board will carefully guard against extortion in any form practiced on the patrons of the fair. A violation of this rule will cause the forfeiture of contract, money paid, and expulsion from the grounds as the Board may direct.
- 4) Under no circumstances will attire, activities or concessions of a questionable nature or a demoralizing tendency be let or in any manner, tolerated upon the grounds or in the buildings. No activity or concession will be permitted where the business is conducted in other than legitimate, ethical and trade-like manner.

OPEN CLASS ENTRIES

Give this your special attention!

1) Entry tags may be received and entries made prior to entry day. Entry tags may be obtained at the Boone County Extension Office during regular business hours or Thursday, July 8 from 5-9 p.m. at the **Boone County Event Center** at the Boone County Fairgrounds, Albion. It is preferred that entry tags be obtained and entries made on Thursday, but this can also be done on Saturday, July 10, 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. **It is recommended that individuals with numerous entries register early and have entry tags ready prior to entry to assist in easy check-in of entries, although this is not mandatory. For information, call Jeryl Kettelson at 402-386-5636. To obtain entry tags or make entries early call Theresa Scheffler at 402-395-2336.**

2) Entries in all classes **MUST** be brought and entered on Saturday, July 10 from 8:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. All entries should be taken to the **East end of the Event Center**. Entries will not be accepted after 12:00 p.m., unless approved by the superintendent. Judging will begin at 1:30 p.m. The building will be closed to the public until after the judging.

3) All classes are open to the State of Nebraska only, with the exception of Farm Products and the School Display. These two classes are open to the residents of Boone County only.

4) All entries must be made or produced by the exhibitor.

5) The Fairboard will use due care to protect all articles placed on exhibition, but in no case assume responsibility should any damage or loss occur.

6) All entries must never have been exhibited previously at the Boone County Fair.

7) Be sure and mark all articles plainly with your name and address.

8) **No exhibit will be allowed to be removed before 8:00 p.m. on the last day of the fair without the consent of the open class superintendent.** Any violation of this rule shall act as a forfeiture of any and all premiums on the article removed.

9) **All exhibits are to be removed after 8:00 p.m. on the last day of the fair, July 14, 2010. Not responsible for articles left after 11:30 p.m. July 14, 2010.**

10) The open class building will be open 11:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Sunday; Monday through Wednesday 11:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.

PREMIUMS

1) Open Class premium money may be collected on Wednesday, July 14, 2010, at the East end of the Event Center after 8:00 p.m. All premiums not collected by that date will be sent to participants by mail. All checks must be cashed by October 10, 2010. Refer any and all matters not covered by the rules to the Fairboard. A special premium of \$6.00 will be awarded to the top exhibitor in each adult class.

The Boone County Fair Board reserves to its Board the final and absolute right to interpret these rules and regulations, and arbitrarily settle and determine all matters, questions, and differences in regard thereto, or otherwise arising out of, connected with, or incident to the fair.
